New business model: Two pension funds in Cologne, Germany, are getting fit for the future with software from adesso insurance solutions

- Solutions for portfolio management, the official reporting system, partner management and a system for the settlement of pension payments are being implemented
- A long-term maintenance agreement was signed.

Dortmund, Cologne, April 26, 2022 – In order to comprehensively modernize their application landscapes, the pension funds Pensionskasse der Caritas VVaG (PKC) and Kölner Pensionskasse VVaG i.L. (KPK) have opted for standard software from adesso insurance solutions' in|sure Ecosphere product family. PKC and KPK have also signed long-term maintenance agreements. The implementation project was launched on April 1, 2022 and is planned to run for almost two years. The aim is to keep the system landscape and the processes sustainable in the long run and to use additional strategic potentials for the new business models of the two German pension funds.

New business model for pension funds

Over the next few years, PKC and KPK will systematically restructure and reorganize their application landscapes to digitalize and modernize the way they do business. The pension funds are already cooperating by sharing costs and benefiting from synergies in system development. This means that pension funds do not necessarily have to develop their own solutions, especially for general regulatory issues, such as insurance supervisory requirements for IT, health insurance allowances for pensioners, and pension insurance association contributions.

As part of a new business model, they also intend to expand portfolio management as a service for other company pension schemes. In the



pension fund market, this approach is an innovative and bold step toward meeting the increasing number of regulatory requirements and toward countering the increasingly challenging interest rate and investment environment by managing portfolios in a cost-efficient manner. To take advantage of the cost benefits of scaling standard software, the Colognebased companies are relying on multi-client software from the in|sure Ecosphere: in|sure CollPhir for portfolio management, in|sure Partner for master data management, in|sure GovInterface for individual contract reporting, and in|sure PenPay for pension accounting.

The customer-oriented "run-off" design gives them new room to maneuver and gives policyholders the prospect of long-term secure benefits. Based on their specific experiences, the Cologne-based funds will also offer partial or complete partnership services "from a single source" to other occupational pension funds and institutions in the future.
